(Jer. 31:31-34)**

Church (Acts 2:37-39)

Has the Kingdom (Church) been established?

Prophecy	Fulfilled
“Latter Days” (Dan. 2:28)	Day of Pentecost (Acts 2:16-17; 3:24)
Roman Empire (Dan. 2:44)	Day of Pentecost (Luke 3:1-2)
Lifetime of some who heard (Mk. 9:1)	Day of Pentecost (Acts 2:1, 14, 22, 38)
When the Law goes forth from Jerusalem (Isa. 2:2-3; Lk. 24:45ff)	Day of Pentecost (Acts 2:1, 38)

How Can I be Sure?

**Jesus said the Kingdom
would come with Power
(Mk. 9:1; Lk. 24:49; Acts 1:6-8)**



**Day of Pentecost
(Acts 2:1-4)**

How can I be sure?

Prophecy revealed a FUTURE Kingdom (II Sam. 7), with a king (Isa. 6), a law (Isa. 2), and citizens that would be forgiven of sins (Jer. 31)

Church Established on Day of Pentecost (Acts 2:38-42)

After Pentecost, church is spoken of as having already existed (Acts 5:11; 8:1; etc.)

Conclusion

- You cannot afford to be uncertain about the establishment of the church.
- Without the forgiveness of your sins you will not be in heaven!

Are you a citizen in the Kingdom of God (His Church)?

- Have you been forgiven of your sins (Acts 2:38)?
- Saints (I Corinthians 1:1-3)
- Those called out of sin (II Peter 2:9)
- Those reconciled unto God (Col. 1:19-23)
- Such are added to the church (Acts 2:41)
